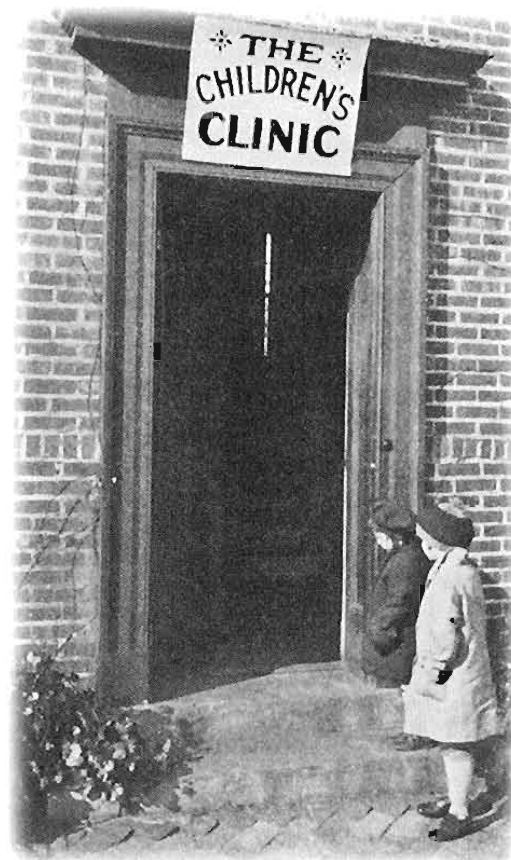

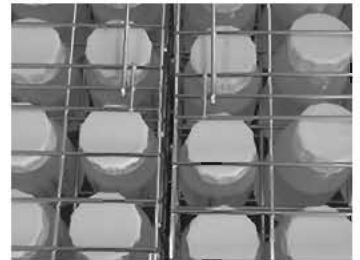
# IT ALL STARTED IN 1896...

The King's Daughters' membership is organized into circles (Adult and Junior) that are located throughout Hampton Roads. Each Circle elects its own leaders, organizes its

own events, contributes hand-sewn items and donates time and money to CHKD. Members also chair and serve on The King's Daughters' major fundraising projects throughout the year. A Board of Directors which governs the organization is elected annually by the membership and is supported by a dedicated staff.

# The King's Daughters YEAR IN REVIEW

## CHKD



The annual gift to CHKD totaled **\$700,000** for FY 2013-2014. These funds were raised through Circle Projects, Major Projects, Canister Funds, and other sources.

Included in the annual gift, The King's Daughters also completed a pledge in this year with the second of two payments toward **\$500,000** to establish The King's Daughters Milk Bank at CHKD.



Think of how far we have come since the days when The King's Daughters delivered milk to families in need. How appropriate for this to come full circle as we again answer the call to provide progressive healthcare for the children of our community.

The King's Daughters Milk Bank at CHKD opened in June 2014. This medically significant program will ensure that fragile NICU patients, who need this nourishing breast milk, will receive this "liquid gold."

The King's Daughters' staff spear headed the creation of a new website launched April of 2014. The staff was active members of: The Downtown 100, Ghent Business Association, Hampton Roads Chamber of Commerce, Hampton Roads Marketing Association, Association of Fundraising Professionals, Retail Alliance, Volunteer Hampton Roads, Virginia Association of Health Auxiliaries and Volunteers (VAHAV), and American Fundraising Professionals.

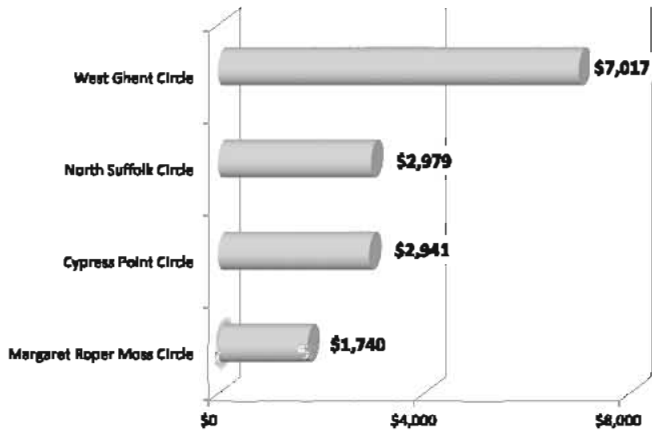

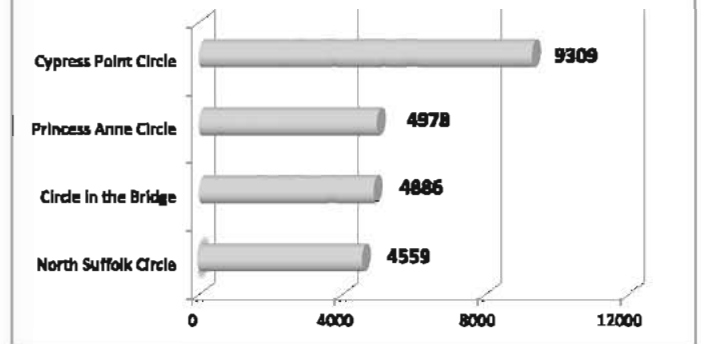

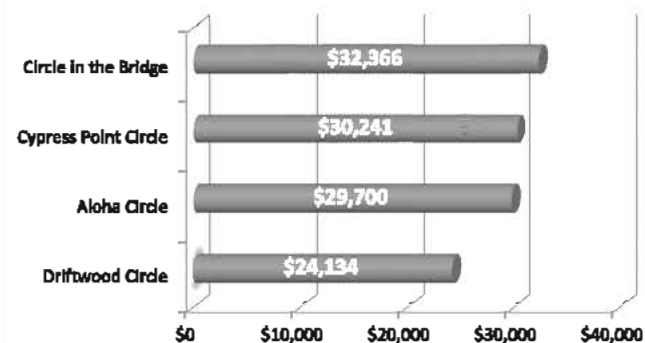
### HIGHEST CANISTER REVENUE



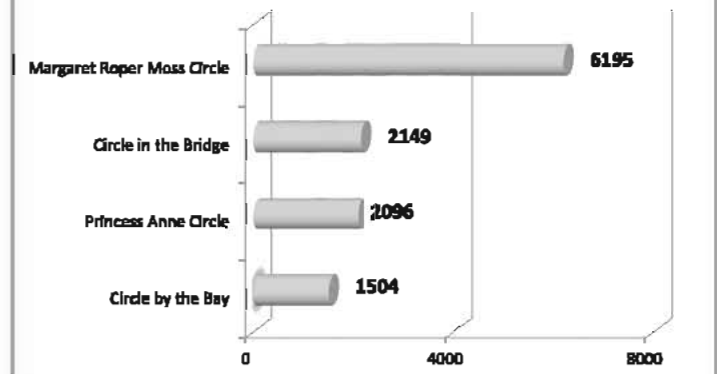
### HIGHEST TOTAL CIRCLE VOLUNTEER HOURS



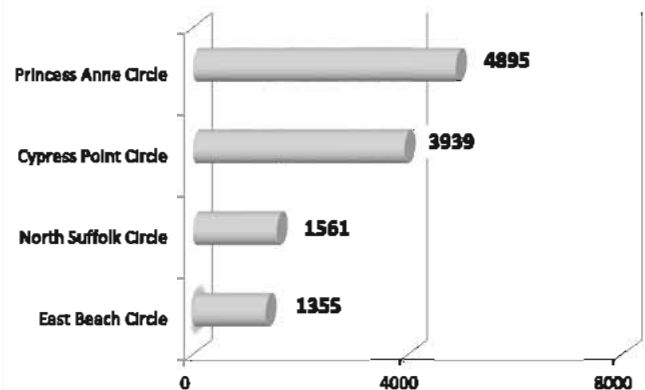
### HIGHEST TOTAL REVENUE



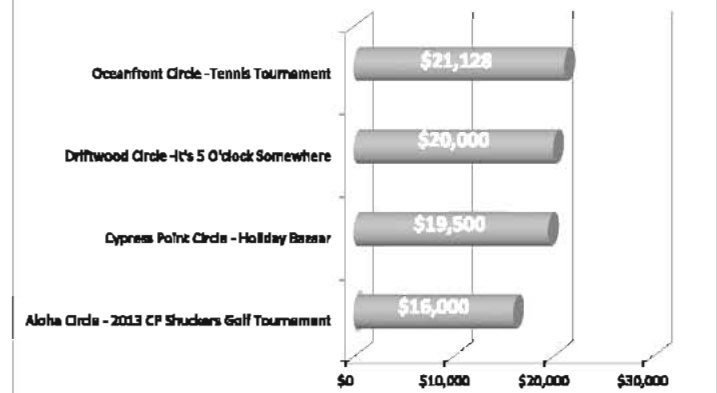
### HIGHEST TOTAL OF GIFTS

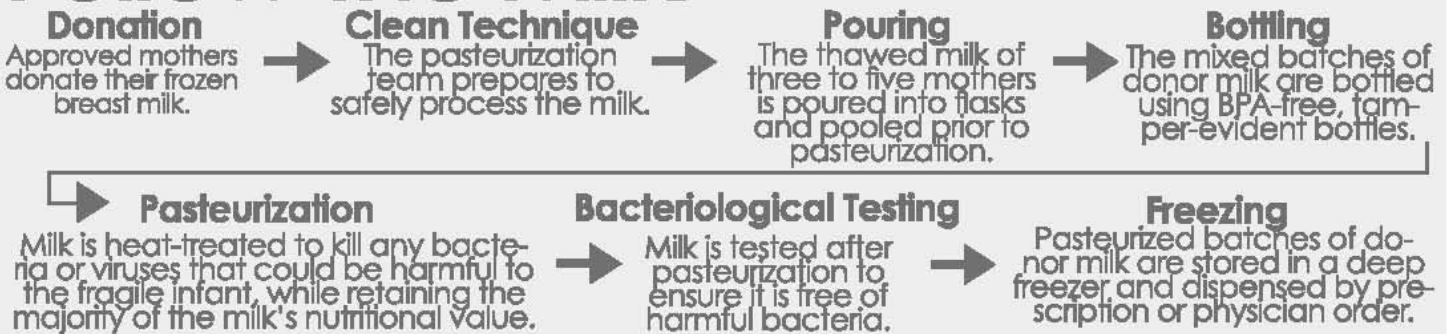
# The King's Daughters Milk Bank at CHKD

Breast milk is the best nutrition for all babies and can be a life-saving treatment for those who are extremely premature or critically ill. Breast milk significantly decreases the odds of life-threatening complications and infections in premature infants during the first months of life. Since many factors can prevent mothers of preterm or critically ill infants from being able to provide a sufficient supply of their own milk,



CHKD has established The King's Daughters Milk Bank to ensure that breast milk is available to the hospital's most fragile babies. The King's Daughters Milk Bank at CHKD is a non-profit, hospital-based donor milk bank with a mission to provide pasteurized milk from carefully screened donors to severely premature and sick infants, improving their potential to survive and thrive. The milk bank will also serve as a resource center for both medical professionals and the general public regarding the benefits of breast milk.

# ALIVE because of donor breast milk

Kay Shields, West Ghent Circle member, is sharing her miraculous story in memory of her mother, Katherine Birsch (Lakewood Circle member). Kay was born 3 months premature, weighing only 2 lbs. (in 1940 this is a miracle story!) The doctor told her parents that her heartbeat was too strong to let her lay there and die. A nurse was hired around the clock to watch over her. Her mother's decision to sit everyday on a gurney at the hospital, watching her daughter in the nursery, and sending her breast milk for her feedings saved Kay's life. After 6 months in the hospital, Kay could finally return home. The true meaning of her story is that Kay would be a candidate for the newly formed Milk Bank today if born in this generation. This is the reason she is so passionate, supportive, and proud that she has been an integral part—as a King's Daughter—in the establishment of The King's Daughters Milk Bank at CHKD and knowing that CHKD has taken this giant step in helping to provide for the survival of premature babies.
