About The King's Daughters

The King's Daughters is a charitable organization that has worked to improve the quality of life for children in our region since 1896. The organization grew from a single nurse who rode a bike around Norfolk to care for sick children, to a series of clinics, to the establishment of Children's Hospital of The King's Daughters in 1961. Today, The King's Daughters have more than 1,000 members who support Children's Hospital of The King's Daughters through fundraising, volunteerism, leadership, and advocacy.

CHKD cares for every child who needs its services regardless of any family's ability to pay. CHKD still relies on The King's Daughters for funds to offset the cost of caring for the region's neediest children. The King's Daughters also serve in leadership positions on CHKD's Boards and volunteer in countless ways in the hospital and its community health centers.

For 123 years, The King's Daughters have provided the financial, leadership, and volunteer support needed to care for our community's children. From saving coupons and trading stamps to hosting parties, golf tournaments, and other events, the pioneering spirit of the founders can still be seen today in the volunteers who continue to support and serve the needs of children and families in our region.

Through a network of more than 45 circles, The King's Daughters raise funds, friends and awareness for CHKD in every corner of our region, serving as powerful advocates for our community's most precious resource.



After 3 ½ years, Eleanor Bradshaw, Margaret Roper Moss Circle, and Edna St. John, Thalia Friendship Circle have successfully organized The King's Daughters historical files. They have spent countless hours going through box after box and dividing the "treasures" into categories and chronological order.

This project will be completed within the next few months and all the materials (over 80 boxes) will be turned over to the Sargeant Memorial Room at the Slover Library. This will be the largest collection of materials ever donated to the archives.

MEMBERSHIP

We are 1,111 members strong in 45 Adult Circles and 9 Junior Circles.

This past year, we welcomed 3 new Circles: Circle of Beach Moms, Alpha Sigma Kappa (ASD) Junior Circle and Cox High School Junior Circle. Carol's Angel Circle retired after serving CHKD since 2005.

THE KING'S DAUGHTERS TRANSPORT UNIT DEDICATION

The King's Daughters funded their second pediatric mobile intensive care ambulance 2015-2017. In June 2018 members of the CHKD Transport Crew spoke at the KD Connect meeting about this new transport; these ambulances are highly specialized, and staffed by specially trained intensive care teams. The King's Daughters are making it possible to provide more critically ill children the life-saving care they need when tragedy strikes. In 2018 the new state-of-the-art transport unit was dedicated.



THRIFT STORE BAG DRIVE

The King's Daughters continued to support CHKD Thrift Stores through individual donations. Circles competed to donate the most bags. The Circle Donation Bag Drive took place in March and generated a total of **7,762 Bags** full of items.

MAJOR PROJECTS

The 2018-2019 Major Projects consisted of Breakfast with Santa, Moonlight and Mistletoe and RunWalk for the Kids.

The total proceeds from these projects was **\$234,771.**



The 6th annual **Moonlight & Mistletoe Gala** was held on Saturday, December 1st at the Norfolk Waterside Marriott. Mary Kathryn Wood "Woo Woo" and Mike Powers of Entercom Communications Norfolk emceed a wonderful evening of dining & dancing along with a live and silent auction. Eleanor "Sugar" Bradshaw, Edward "Buzz" Heidt, Jr. and Dr. Donald Nuss received the 2018 Dr. Donald Lewis Award.



Breakfast with Santa presented in conjunction with Busch Gardens Williamsburg was held on November 17th at the Westin, Town Center Virginia Beach. This family focused holiday event included breakfast, silent auction of trees and baskets, specialty train displays by The Atlantic "S" Gaugers Tidewater Division, performances by The Hurrah Players, Norfolk Christian Jazz Band, Quality Music and Dance and a visit with Santa for each child.

The 14th Annual RunWalk for the Kids was held on May 11th at Norfolk's Waterside District with 1,791 participants. More than 70 teams made up from families, friends, businesses, CHKD employees and patients came together. CHKD Sports Medicine once again provided the first aid team. Dominion Enterprises team won the award for the most participants and Team Coastal Junior Circle won the KD Circle award for fundraising. More than 225 volunteers helped with this project.



COMMUNITY

The King's Daughters continue to focus their attention and energy on supporting CHKD in their efforts to provide superior health care for children in our community.

Through dedicated volunteer hours in excess of **49,270**

and extreme dedication, we are fortunate to have a diverse membership that is full of creativity, passion and innovation. Our volunteer efforts are as important today as they were over 123 years ago. Using the Independent Sector's 2019 estimate for the value of a volunteer hour of \$25.43, these 49,270 volunteer hours represent an equivalent monetary value of \$1,252,936.

CIRCLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Circle projects and revenues raised \$391,432.86 from 90 events. Members donated 22,113 linens, knitted and sewn items and gifts. Hand-sewn surgery bears for patients totaled 12,731. Members collectively contributed 49,270 volunteer hours.



SIGNATURE PROJECT - CANISTERS

Our first community-wide fundraiser started in 1906 to raise funds to provide milk for babies. The King's Daughters Signature Project, with the generous help of local merchants, their customers and our own CHKD Thrift Stores, raised an incredible **\$253,359.53**.

Kroger Rewards – In Fiscal year 2018-2019 raised \$781.59, and previously; FY1718 \$733.54, FY1617 \$361.29.

Our 15 member King's Daughters Board worked diligently to provide oversight and guidance. They are an incredible team working tirelessly with all The King's Daughters, CHKD employees and the community at large to ensure the continuation of The King's Daughters Legacy and that all organizational goals and expectations are met.



THE KING'S DAUGHTERS MILK BANK AT CHKD

Five years ago, The King's Daughters provided \$500,000 to start a Milk Bank to ensure that babies in our NICU have access to this life saving "liquid gold". Last year, The King's Daughters Milk Bank received 347,297 ounces from 390 donors bringing our five year total to over 1.4 million ounces from close to 3000 donors.

Today, the Milk Bank is one of only 27 non-profit milk banks in North America, only one of 3 in a children's hospital and the first and only Milk Bank in Virginia.

Thanks to The King's Daughters for their ongoing support of our new facility and enhanced ability to process, store and deliver this precious gift of human milk.

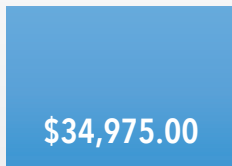

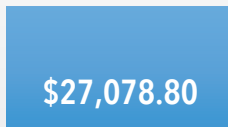
Highest Revenue from a Single Circle Project

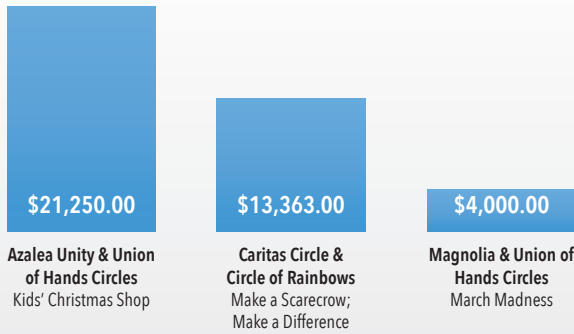

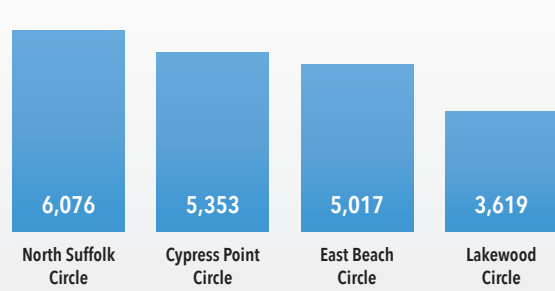

Highest Revenue from a Joint Circle Project



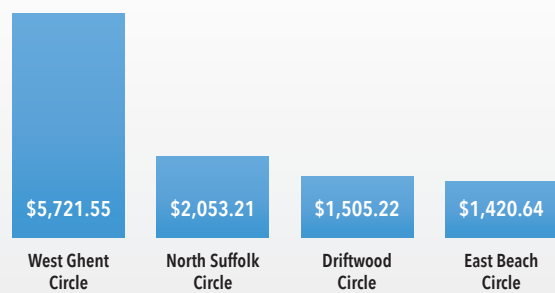
Highest Total Circle Volunteer Hours



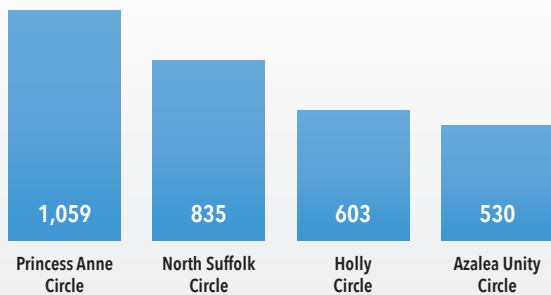
Highest Total Revenue



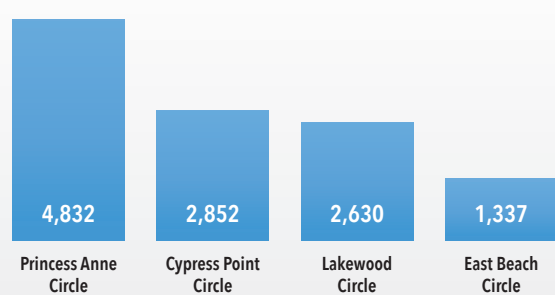
Highest Canister Revenue
