HISTORY

In 1896, The King's Daughters, a local women's service organization, hired a nurse to care for the sick in Norfolk's poorest neighborhoods. In her first year, she made 1,771 house calls on foot. In her second year, The King's Daughters bought her a bicycle so she could cover more ground. Families who could not pay for her services received them for free, establishing the foundation of charitable care that would come to define The King's Daughters and shape the future of healthcare for children in our region and beyond.

In those early days, The King's Daughters made sure that children with contagious illnesses like typhoid, malaria, dysentery, and tuberculosis got the care they needed. Later, we encouraged and provided vaccinations to prevent these same illnesses. After operating a series of ever-larger clinics, we set in motion plans to build a full-service children's hospital. The King's Daughters raised nearly \$1 million and broke ground on Children's Hospital of The King's Daughters in 1959. The building was dedicated on April 23, 1961.

As we celebrate the hospital's 60th year, CHKD is now the heart of a comprehensive health system dedicated exclusively to children. As King's Daughters, we have been instrumental drivers of that growth, raising much needed funds, advocating for children's health concerns, and volunteering in countless ways to bring comfort and care to our patients.

Today, as we celebrate The King's Daughters' 125th year, our organization is more vibrant than ever with a staff that supports more than 1,000 volunteer Circle members organized into 44 adult Circles and 6 junior Circles. In a year where the pandemic has been ever prevalent, Circles have hosted many unique fundraising projects in the absence of in-person events such as RunWalk for the Kids, Breakfast with Santa, and Moonlight & Mistletoe. Circles are looking forward, not back as they lend a hand once again. They also hand-sewed bears for children at CHKD going through surgery and made many other handmade items for patients and their families.

As King's Daughters, we have continued to donate time and treasure, heart and soul. In June 2019, we completed our pledge of \$1 million toward CHKD's Mental Health Hospital, and last year we paid \$330,000 toward a new pledge of \$2 million. In our latest endeavor to fulfill this new pledge, this year, we donated \$552,309 as our annual gift. \$480,000 of that donation went to CHKD's Mental Health Hospital.

"It is impossible to overstate the importance of The King's Daughters to our community," says Jim Dahling, President and CEO of CHKD. "Their founding premise, that every child deserves equal access to high-quality pediatric care, has benefitted generations of children and remains our guiding principle today. We are incredibly grateful for their strong historic partnership and will continue to rely on their wisdom, leadership, and advocacy efforts in the future."

The King's Daughters

has many groups of member-volunteers throughout Hampton Roads, each with a unique name to tell them apart. Collectively, we call these groups Circles.

In 1962, The King's Daughters introduced a new fundraiser that was a crowd-favorite for years.

What was the event called?

Like today's

healthcare heroes during the COVID-19 pandemic, The King's Daughters nursing staff cared for patients during the flu pandemic of 1918.

Resources were limited, but the nurses continued their efforts.

Who was president of the United States when The King's Daughters was founded?

How about when CHKD was founded?

The King's Daughters built The Children's Clinic in the 1920s. It was the home to prenatal and delivery services as well as treatment rooms for sick children. The cornerstone of The Children's Clinic can still be found on CHKD's Norfolk campus.

Where?

Today, CHKD has 14 health centers across Hampton Roads to allow families easier access to care. In 1924, The King's Daughters opened the first two of ten health centers.

Where in Norfolk were these two centers?

Today, we call it our Signature Project Canister program, but in what year was the Empty Milk Bottle Campaign officially launched to raise funds for the Milk program?

Today, the infant mortality rate for Norfolk is **6.6 DEATHS per 1,000 BIRTHS.**

However, in the early 1900s, the rate was 138 per 1,000 births. The King's Daughters' nurses and doctors worked tirelessly, and by 1939, the rate had dropped to 45 deaths per 1,000 births – a 67.4% decrease.
