## \$850,000.00!!!!

### NCUKD's Largest Gift in a single fiscal year (2006-07) to CHKD.

Thanks to the Major Projects, Circle Projects, Special Projects, Canisters and Endowment Campaign Contributions, NCUKD was able to donate \$850,000.00 to CHKD for the 2006-07 fiscal year. (\$300,000 given in Jan. 2007; \$550,000.00 give in June 2007)

This is no small feat for a dedicated group of volunteers in the Hampton Road's Community! This would not have been possible without the devotion of our King's Daughters Circles, their families and friends.

Our giving history for the last 3 years is as follows:

2004-2005: \$542,169.94  
2005-2006: \$700,000.00  
2006-2007: \$850,000.00

If we keep this momentum going in the same manner, we may be able to donate, oh...say, \$1 million in a fiscal year to CHKD.... determination and dedication will get us there!

Our success in 2004-2007 was under the leadership of the outgoing president, **Nancy H. Nusbaum (Horizon Circle)**. Nancy served as NCUKD president since the 2004-05 fiscal year. Under her leadership, the organization accomplished many milestones such as: increase in membership, increase in number of Circles, increases in community awareness and an increase in donations to CHKD.

During her term, Nancy encountered a few personal situations that would have made others give up, but Nancy persevered and we are grateful to her for that. ## Don't Chance It....

(Circle rules in regards to raffles/chances)

Due to Gaming Commission regulations, as of August 1, 2007 **Circles of the Norfolk City Union of The King's Daughters will no longer be allowed to hold public raffles.**

### What this means to you:

Circles may hold a "chance" within a Circle event that they are having; i.e. Holiday Bazaar can sell "chance tickets" at their event to win a TV, Salon Day, etc.

Circles **cannot** publicize a raffle of any kind throughout the community.

If your Circle wants to sell chance tickets for a particular item(s), please contact Natalie Carducci in the NCUKD office to get the rules and regulations.

In your efforts to raise funds, friends and awareness for CHKD, remember, **CHKD does not endorse or allow door-to-door solicitations.** This
