Each year, more than 500 babies are admitted to CHKD's NICU. Many have been born prematurely---some as much as 16 weeks before they are due---while others face life-threatening illnesses or birth defects. CHKD's NICU babies need highly specialized equipment to help them survive, from temperature- and humidity-controlled incubators, to high-frequency ventilators, to minute versions of everyday items like blood pressure cuffs and diapers. Help us make sure the children in our community have the best chance for a healthy future.

A note from Chef Scott Bernheisel

To Our Holly Ball Patrons:

I have been creating menus for the Holly Ball for the last 20 years and it has always been a “culinary challenge” for me. I remember back in the day when the taste panel for the ball consisted of 20 or more chairpersons – you think feeding 400 guests is difficult!

This year was especially a great challenge; with so many ideas to incorporate into the 1950’s era and Hollywood theme. In my research I found many different influences. WWII had ended and the soldiers were introduced to Asian south pacific flavors. Women left the job force and returned to the home to save time and energy. Women’s magazines confirmed popular recipes such as tuna noodle and green bean casseroles, meatloaf with mashed potatoes. Grilling in the backyard became popular as well. The invention of frozen vegetables allowed for more choices. Chex Mix was a signature snack in front of the TV. Food companies were quick to supply the ingredients for the “Americanized” version of Sukiyaki, Egg Foo Yung, Chow Mein, Pizza, Lasagna, BBQ Meats, all which were visibly in 1950’s cookbooks.

TV was a way of gathering information, the movie star was born! Upper echelon enjoyed such things as broiled grapefruit, seafood cocktails, glazed shrimp, cheese balls, short ribs, chicken croquettes and soufflés. The famous Grace Kelly personally selected menu favorites of caviar and Blinis, Duck a l’ Orange, French style green beans, heart of palm salad, fruit and cheeses.

All of the above research went into the menu planning of your meal this evening, I have thoroughly enjoyed working with the Holly Ball committee and am honored to be able to help and support CHKD. I hope you enjoy this evening’s meal as much as I enjoyed preparing it for you!
