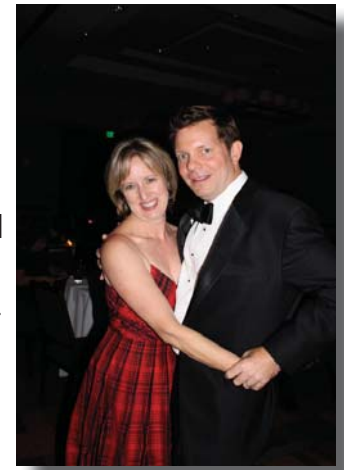

## **A Message from CHKD**

This message comes from Jim Dahling, President and CEO of CHKD. It was originally emailed to all CHKD employees on January 8, 2010.

*"Everyone is probably aware that the State of Virginia is in a dire situation with regard to funding the State budget. Governor Kaine provided his proposed budget that included substantial spending cuts along with a number of revenue increases – taxes – that Governor-Elect McDonnell has said he will oppose. This means that the state will have to make even deeper cuts than those proposed by Governor Kaine in a budget that already significantly affects CHKD.*

*The proposed budget will cut Medicaid payments to CHKD by \$3.1 million each of the next two years.*

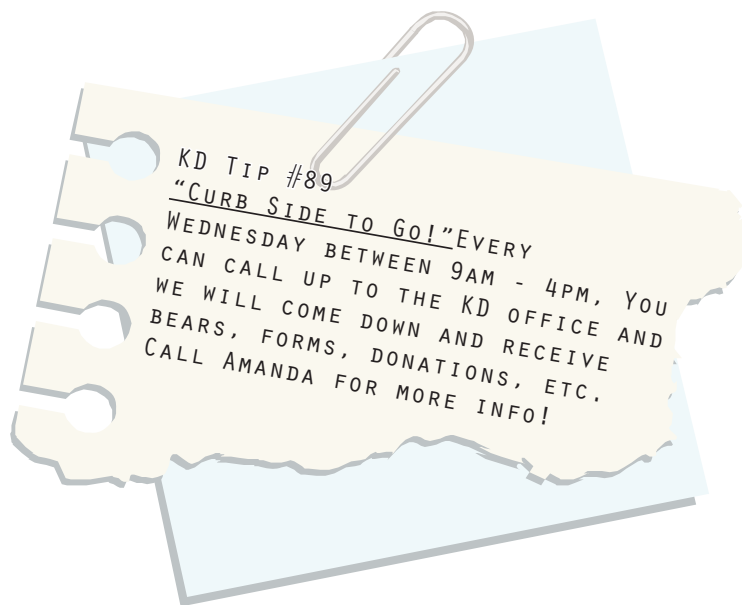
*We are vigorously appealing to our elected officials and are telling them the very real consequences for CHKD and the children we serve if the Medicaid program is cut. You may hear me describe the impact on CHKD in terms of cuts to positions, programs and services. We must share our story with legislators and the media. Everyone should be aware, however, that we have no definitive decisions on our actions and will not until the state budget is finalized during the General Assembly session this spring. The reason for this is because I have significant optimism that the state will understand CHKD's unique situation and will help protect our core mission and services.*

*We will keep everyone informed and involved as this situation unfolds. We may hold employee forums, and we may ask you to advocate for CHKD through calls, emails and letters to legislators. So please be on the lookout for additional communications from me. And, as always, we will work together as we face these challenges."*
