In June 2010, we will make our final payment to The King's Daughters' \$1 million endowment fund for the Child Abuse Center and Nursing Scholarship Programs. We are proud to say that as of May 2010 we have 100% participation from all Circles! We will celebrate at the October Annual Recognition Celebration.

Circle participation was the driving force of this campaign. Your commitment to the endowment will ensure that these programs which are vital to the community will sustain in uncertain economic times. CHKD only uses the interest, up to 5%, from the Endowment Funds. Our principle investment will always remain intact as the Endowment is designed to grow and to provide perpetual funds for CHKD.

Child Abuse Program offers children a safe and nurturing environment in which to begin the healing process in the aftermath of abuse and neglect. The program provides compassionate diagnostic, assessment and treatment services and seeks to coordinate the efforts of various community agencies working together on behalf of the abused child. The CHKD Child Abuse Program begins the healing process through an innovative program that honors the abused child's need for safety, dignity and privacy.

The Nursing Scholarship Program benefits both current and future nurses. Nationwide there is a work-force shortage in the nursing field and is predicted to last throughout the next decade. The fund will help existing professionals pursue advanced training and/or enhancement as well as assist nursing students, making it possible for CHKD to offer hands-on externship programs.
