In 2013, The King's Daughters established an award to honor Dr. Donald Lewis. Dr. Lewis, who unexpectedly passed away in 2012, was a well-known CHKD neurologist, educator, researcher and outspoken advocate for chil-

dren's health. The purpose of this award is to recognize someone who, like Dr. Lewis, inspires others and is willing to take whatever action necessary to better the lives of children.



This year, Sarah Bishop has been selected as the recipient of this award. Sarah, a member of Maltese Cross Circle, is a dedicated King's Daughter and advocate for children; she has worked tirelessly for children over the years in and around the community and within CHKD. She is currently a member of the CHKD Child Abuse Board and recently completed 18 years of service on the Children's Health Systems Board. Sarah will be recognized at this year's Moonlight and Mistletoe on December 5, 2015.

Thanks to the amazing support of our hundreds of volunteers, we completed another remarkably successful fiscal year. In May, we spent a blissful day with friends at the Tour de Cuisine in East Beach and relished in the beautiful homes within this waterfront community and enjoyed fine food from top local restaurants; special thanks to Presenting Sponsor The International Culinary School at The Art Institute of Virginia Beach. In June, we celebrated the 10th Anniversary of RunWalk for the Kids and enjoyed a morning of walking, running, volunteering and listening to live



music. A special thanks to Presenting Sponsors: Marathon Consulting, Wavy TV 10 and Entercom Radio as well all other sponsors . There is literally no way these events could happen without the help of all of our sponsors and volunteers. We are so thankful for your support.

In June, we also celebrated the one year anniversary of the opening of The King's Daughters' Milk Bank. Dr. Michele Brenner, Medical Director, spoke at the June KD Connect meeting touting just how much milk the Milk Bank has received since the first day and has begun selling excess milk to other area hospitals. The donor milk is often a life saver to our NICU patients who cannot utilize or don't have access to their own mother's milk but need the valuable nutrients found in breast milk.

This past fiscal year, The King's Daughters organized 91 circle projects and 4 major projects. Through this benefaction, we are proud to announce we donated \$600,000 to Children's Hospital of The King's Daughters for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015.

As we enter into the new fiscal year, be on the lookout for information about our new and improved Leader's Orientations featuring breakout sessions that will be more interactive and informative. In addition, you will learn of our efforts to raise funds for a new transport unit. This vehicle costs \$650,000 and is not just a transport unit - it is a lifesaving "hospital on wheels" that allows medical care to begin immediately upon pickup making every critical second count. Finally, we are looking forward to seeing you at the Annual Recognition Celebration on October 6, 2015 – a time when we can offer our humble thanks to the countless hours you put in to support the children of our community.


