EVON TICE has been Chairman of Linens & Gifts for Cypress Point Circle since 1997 – the inception of the Circle. Evon is a stellar Cypress Point Circle member who has cut and sewn the majority of approximately 45,000 bears. Not only does she shop for the fabric, launder it, lay the pattern, cut and sew the bears, she paints the faces. Her car is on auto-pilot to The King's Daughters



office. Over the years, Evon has encouraged "bear clinics" to teach members the correct way to stuff bears. Along the journey, she has had assistance from different Co-Chairs – Butch Burgess, Pam Taylor and Barbara McDonald, to name a few. Since joining the Circle in 2006, Barbara, has been our Circle's #1 bear stuffer. To date, Barbara has stuffed 8,058 of the bears Evon has cut and sewn.

In addition to sewing bears, Evon has created many items to sell at our Circle's vendor table – a presence at a variety of fund raisers. The Holiday Bazaar, especially, has been a perfect outlet for 10 years. Some items of Evon's have been baby quilts, tooth fairy pillows, activity book and crayon holders, totes and infant receiving blankets. She has collected lovely knitted baby items – such as sweaters, caps, booties, neo-natal crib covers, and beautiful baby quilt crib sets from



current and past Circle members, family, friends, and outside sources.

Evon's husband, Ray, has often commented on how much our Circle ladies read, as the magazines collected for The King's Daughters mount higher in their home. Evon will request KD Wish List items from our membership as well, keeping us informed of what specific items are needed.

Evon is always appreciative of all that our Circle ladies, friends and volunteers do for the bears. She is forever encouraging us (and sometimes badgering us!!) to do more bears. As she reminds us, it is for the children at CHKD.

Evon is a volunteer and supporter of all Circle fund raisers. While she is stepping down from the Chairmanship of Linens & Gifts after 17 years, she will continue to be there for the bears and for us. 

NOMINATING TO THE KD BOARD

CRITERIA AND EXPECTATIONS THE KING'S DAUGHTERS BOARD OF DIRECTORS

A candidate for membership on the BOARD OF DIRECTORS of THE KING'S DAUGHTERS should meet the following criteria:

Criteria/Qualifications:

- Be a member of a King's Daughters Circle for a minimum of two years.
- Have worked on a Major Project or been the Chair of a Circle project or been a Circle Leader.
- May not be an employee of Children's Hospital of The King's Daughters.

Expectations:

- Ability to attend monthly board meetings
- Ability to attend board committee meetings as necessary
- Ability to attend KD Connect meetings (4-5 per year).
- Ability to serve as a liaison to Circles
- Ability to become a hospital tour guide
- Ability to sign a conflict of interest form and confidentiality agreement.

• Ability to become educated in the workings of The King's Daughters and the other corporations under the umbrella of the Children's Health System, Inc.

- Ability to support CHKD's Annual Giving Campaign
- Ability to support and attend The King's Daughters' Major Projects each year.
- Ability to act as a spokesperson for The King's Daughters.
- Possess a demonstrated commitment to community service, support for The King's Daughters mission and values.
- Willingness to accept additional duties as assigned by The King's Daughters Board of Directors' President.

Please Note:

All KD Board of Directors members:

• May not hold a leadership office in their own Circle or on a Major Project's committee unless approved by The Executive Committee of The King' Daughters Board of Directors

May not serve as their Circle's representative at KD Connect Meetings

• With the exception of The King's Daughters' President, who is a Class A member of the Children's Health System Board and an Executive Committee Member who automatically serves as a ex-offico member on the Children's Health Foundation Board, a King's Daughters Board Member may serve on a Children's Health System affiliate Boards with the approval of the Executive Committee.
