Membership—Updates, communications, etc.



Funds from our major projects this year will go toward the purchase of

CHKD Transport Unit!

- This 10-ton vehicle serves as a rolling pediatric/neonatal intensive care unit equipped with essential state of the art technology
- Each year, CHKD transports approximately 1,200 patients
- Two transport teams operate 24 hours a day, 365 days a year
- Distraction components include: iPads, televisions, and other items that traditional ambulances do not offer
