Also, historical rumor has it that the first bicycle for the nurse was purchased with gambling winnings that a member took from her husband stating, "I don't approve of you gambling, but since you won I will put the money to good use."

I have been delighted to attend a number of Circle meetings and have enjoyed listening to and learning from you. The amount of dedication and passion held by each of you is amazing and energizing. While I am inspired when reading about efforts of the women before us, I am truly inspired and motivated by today's members. While raising funds for CHKD is an important part of what we do; The King's Daughters is so much more – it is an organization where lifelong friendships are formed, it is an organization that helps mentor community advocates, it is an organization that helps us grow, learn, and give back while having fun.

2016 Dr. Donald W. Lewis Award Winner

In 2013, The King's Daughters established an award to honor Dr. Donald Lewis, a beloved CHKD pediatric neurologist, educator, researcher and outspoken advocate for children's health, who unexpectedly passed away in 2012. The purpose of this award is to recognize someone who possesses that same sense of optimism and enthusiasm as Dr. Lewis; who inspires others and is willing to take whatever action necessary to better the lives of children.

This year's honoree is Dr. Ed Karotkin. Dr. Karotkin came to CHKD in 1978 as the second neonatologist and helped to build our incredible neonatology program. Through the years he has not only made a difference in many neonates lives, but was the driving force behind the development of CHKD's Resource Mothers program, an initiative that minimizes expectant mothers' health risks and decreases infant mortality by ensuring young mothers receive the appropriate prenatal and pediatric care, along with the guidance of older, more experienced women, or resource mothers.

Among other honors, Karotkin has received a Volunteer of the Year Award (Greater Hampton Roads Division) from the March of Dimes, a humanitarian award from the National Council for Community and Justice and a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Department of Pediatrics at Eastern Virginia Medical School in Norfolk. He is one of Physicians for Peace's three 2010 Medical Diplomat award winners and in 2012 was

recognized as an Inside Business Health Care Hero.
