A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT



Dear Fellow King's Daughters,

Many thanks to everyone who attended our February KD Connect meeting. Highlights of the meeting included the announcement that the Children's Health System Board has approved the construction of a \$50 million Behavioral/Mental Health Building. The building will be located on the property adjacent to the current Medical Tower. The facility will include inpatient beds as well as areas for a comprehensive outpatient program. The King's Daughters' recognition of this being a top priority for

children in our community coupled with our \$1 million pledge for behavioral/mental health services was instrumental in bringing this need to the forefront.

In order to make this building a reality, we must have approval from the Virginia Department of Health for a certificate of public need (COPN) for 60 inpatient beds. Each King's Daughter is being asked to write a letter of support to Marissa Levine, MD, MPH, State Health Commissioner, Virginia Department of Health for the approval of this COPN. A KD eblast will be sent by early March with a sample letter. If you do not have access to email, please contact the KD office and they can provide sample wording for your letter. I cannot stress enough how important it is for this COPN request to have our support.

At our February KD Connect meeting, we celebrated one of our most special projects: The KD Bear. Many thanks to the East Beach, Lakewood and Cypress Point Circles for helping demonstrate the steps to make a bear. The KD staff also developed a slide show "A Day in the Life of a Bear". Can you believe that we made over 13,000 bears last year for children having surgery? But more important is how special these bears are for the children and their parents. A Circle member shared a story she was told by a nurse when the surgery waiting room "ran out" of bears. A child, who had multiple surgeries in the past, was in for yet another surgery. Unfortunately, there wasn't a bear for this child. The child, fearfully, looked to his doctor and asked "if there are no bears, does this mean I am going to die?" I am sure you are as touched as I that our bears, tooth fairy pillows, blankets and NICU and cancer caps are as important as the funds we raise. No matter a Circle's involvement it is all important and so very necessary! Be proud of all that you do. I now that I am!

I hope to see you all at the April KD Connect meeting on Tuesday, April 10th at the Westin in Town Center, Virginia Beach.




