## CHKD THRIFT STORES KD CIRCLES DONATION BAG DRIVE GUIDELINES

- 1.** Feel free to collect items from friends, family members, neighbors, nearby businesses, etc. Each donation helps!
- 2.** Suggested donations include: **CLOTHING, KNICK-KNACKS, GLASSWARE, HOUSEHOLD ITEMS**, or anything "**re-sellable!!!**" (Note: Large items such as furniture, cable ready tv's, computers, etc. will be accepted, but will not be counted as part of this donation drive.)
- 3.** Each bag of items is worth one point. A typical grocery size bag is sufficient. (A large garbage bag filled with items is worth only one point). Make sure bags are full!One item per bag will not count as a full bag.
- 4.** Donations of empty bags (plastic or brown grocery bags) are accepted, but not counted as part of donation drive.
- 5.** Contest begins Friday, March 6, 2020 and ends on Monday, March 9, 2020. Prize winners will be recognized at the April Annual Meeting.
- 6. DO NOT DELIVER CIRCLE DONATIONS TO THE THRIFT STORES.** Only donations received at your Circle's pick-up will be counted toward your Circle's total donation.

**Each Circle needs to appoint one Circle Bag Drive Representative who is responsible for the following:**

- Collecting donated item bags in one central location.
- Keeping a record of bags collected the recording sheet provided by The King's Daughters office.
- Distributing donation receipts to Circle members who have donated items.
- Scheduling one pick up with the CHKD Thrift Stores (622-KIDS, Southside or 874-5437, Peninsula)
- Receiving documentation from the Thrift Store regarding pick-up and number of donated bags.
